



## VACCINATION - GARDASIL

Since the 1<sup>st</sup> of February 2012 all girls between the age of 11 – 12 are offered vaccination against HPV-virus, causing 70 % of all cases of cervical cancer, for free.

The vaccine called Gardasil is a well-tried vaccine that is being used in many countries. At least 23 millions of women all over the world are already vaccinated with Gardasil. Most of the women don't get any side effects at all. However, a few can get a swelling and/or redness and become sore at the injection site. Some can also get transient fever, feeling tired and/or get muscle- or headache.
